Position Summary

REAP Food Group is hiring for an UpRoot Food Truck Culinary Coordinator for the 2024 event season. The coordinator will work in collaboration with REAP Food Group's Event Coordinator and partner chefs to plan and execute between 15-20 events between May and October 2024. The coordinator will be responsible for operating the truck including driving, maintenance, general upkeep, and assisting with food preparation. This position is an excellent opportunity for those with interest in culinary arts, entrepreneurship, food truck management, food justice, sustainability, and the local food system. The UpRoot food truck is a 22-foot truck with a fully operational mobile kitchen. The truck includes 2 coolers, a three-basin sink, a water heater, two 40 gallon water tanks, an oven with 4 burners, a flat cook-top, and deep fryer.

Who We Are

REAP Food Group, a non-profit organization based in Madison, WI, believes we can transform communities, economies, and lives through the power of good food. We are passionate about creating an equitable, local, and sustainable food system. We strive to be curious, inclusive, catalysts for change, and collaborators. Who You Are

You are mission-driven and have a deep connection to contributing a more equitable food system. You have experience in culinary arts, a desire to learn from chefs, and a passion to learn how to operate a 22-foot food truck. You are highly organized, are comfortable operating a large vehicle, have strong communication skills, and are responsive to changing needs.

What You'll Do

- Operate the food truck by driving to and from events
- Open and close the food truck for each event
- Maintain cleanliness of food truck on a per use basis; complete required paperwork
- Assist chefs with food preparation before and during events
- Fuel food truck at approved fueling locations; complete required paperwork
- Ability to operate food truck in a safe and legal manner
- Handle cash payments and credit card transactions, complete required paperwork, dependent on event
- Reserve commercial kitchen space for food preparation work

Required Qualifications

- Valid US driver's license and clean driving record (no moving violations in the past two years, no major violations in the past ten years, and no DUI citations)
- Experience driving large vans, trucks, or similar large vehicles
- ServSafe Certified, or completion within 30 days of hire (cost covered by REAP)
- Experience in food service industry with food preparation following public health guidelines
- Ability to understand and carry out oral and written instructions
- Ability to lift up to 50 pounds
- Ability to stand for extended periods of time
- Comfort with working in enclosed spaces for extended periods
- Ability to work in diverse weather conditions such as hot, cold, wet, humid and windy condition

Desired Qualifications

- Personable and ability to work as part of a team as well as individually
- Experience interacting with socially, economically, racially and/or ethnically diverse populations
- Passionate about creating a equitable local food system

What Else You Should Know:

REAP Food Group's physical office location is at Garver Feed Mill. The coordinator will have access to this space along with any supplies and equipment provided to all employees. The food truck is currently licensed with FEED Kitchen at 1219 N Sherman Ave. Food preparation occurs before events at FEED Kitchen with additional prep directly on the truck. The truck is parked at the Madison Metropolitan School District central office located at 4711 Pflaum Rd. The coordinator will need to pick up the truck at the Pflaum Rd location and return it to this location after each event.

Additionally, the UpRoot Food Truck Culinary Coordinator will be responsible for preparing/opening up the food truck for the season in May and for winterizing the food truck in October.

This is an hourly position with hours on a per event basis from May 2024 through October 2024 and will plan and execute 15-20 culinary events throughout the summer, with an average of 10-15 hours per event. Pay rate of \$20.00 per hour.
